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### Walk to School Week 15-19 May.



Our school is taking part in Walk to School Week. The nationwide event is organised by walking charity Living Streets and designed to help pupils experience first-hand the importance of walking to school.

This year's challenge, Walk with Wildlife, encourages children to travel actively to school every day of the week. Meeting various animals along the way, they'll learn about the important reasons to walk and the difference it can make for individuals, communities and the planet!

Each pupil will be challenged to travel sustainably (walk, wheel, scoot, cycle or Park and Stride) to school every day for one week using the wallchart and stickers to log their journeys. Each class will work collectively to make as many active journeys to school as possible across the week. Individual activity diaries, daily stickers and end of week pupil rewards will complement this activity, reinforcing the benefits and keeping children engaged. The children will be bringing home their activity diaries tonight.
